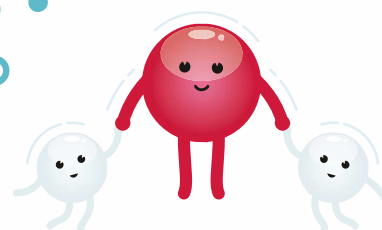
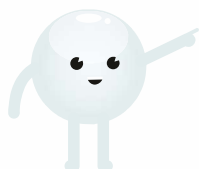
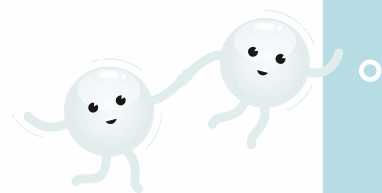
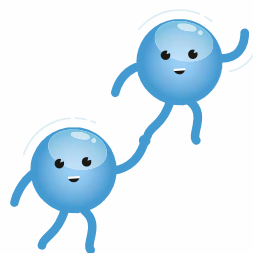


A very warm welcome to 'The Secret World of Gases' national programme
